It should be known Alkaline Hydrolysis, Aquamation, Water Based Cremation and Aqua Cremation are interchangeable terms and all share the same meaning.

All families on Long Island and all of New York State now have Aquamation as a choice for their pet and should be a part of every Veterinarian's service offerings to the families they serve. Aquamation will enhance your end of life service offerings as it is the future of pet aftercare at prices less than you are paying now for flame cremation.

It should be noted; **Aquamation is not flame cremation**, Aquamation is a completely different aftercare process and shouldn't be confused with flame cremation in the same way it shouldn't be confused with traditional burial. Aquamation is not in conflict with any contractual obligation a Veterinary Hospital, Clinic or practice has with a flame crematory. We don't own, possess or use flame cremation equipment to incinerate animals. It's been determined there is no conflict as we are not competing with any flame crematory. From a legal perspective, Aquamation is a completely different pet disposition procedure from flame cremation.

**What is Aquamation?** Aquamation is a flameless cremation process that uses water instead of fire to return a pet back to mother nature.

- There are no emissions of harmful greenhouse gases into the atmosphere we all share and breathe.
- There is over a 90% energy savings when compared to flame-based cremation.
- Aquamation provides 1/10 the carbon footprint of cremation.
- 20% more ash remains returned to the families you serve.
- **Price Points are less than flame Cremation.** There is no financial consequence to the Veterinarians we serve but the environmental impact and difference you can make to the world we live in is immeasurable.
